## Registration Procedures

\*\* Classes are limited to 20 students maximum, therefore early registration is highly recommended.

### To apply for all CPBS classes:

- 1) Fill out an application form (download it from the web-site) and bring it to the Cedar Point Office. If you are a non-UNL student, you may mail or FAX (402 472-2083) it to us, then discuss it over the phone.
- 2) Pay your deposit (session room & board fees) at the Bursar's office in 121 Canfield Administration building, and bring the receipt back to 101 Manter. This deposit must be paid in full and is non-refundable. The Bursar will accept cash, check or money order.
- 3) Return to the Cedar Point Office in early April to pick up your information packet. It will include maps, instructions on what to bring, etc.

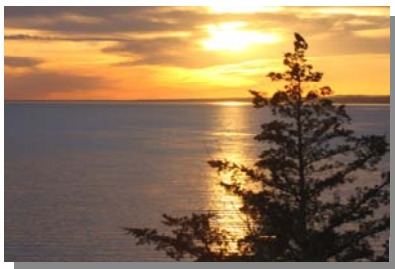
